



PERMIT FOR ACCESS AND ENTRY - NUNAVIK INUIT LANDS (NIL)

TO: MANON SORAIS

The Makivvik Corporation (hereafter Makivvik) hereby authorizes the bearer the right to access and entry (the "Permit") the Nunavik Inuit Lands (the "NIL") subject to the following terms and conditions to which the Permittee hereby agrees:

1. This permit is issued in accordance with all terms and conditions of the Nunavik Inuit Land Claim Agreement (NILCA);
2. This Permit is intended for:

Activity: Research fieldwork, the research team will visit Long Island for two short-term visits in the summer of 2023 (from June 15 - 30 and from August 8-31). During the visits, a team of two research scientists and Eeyou land users would explore the island, count Canada geese breeding pairs in selected sections, and observe eggs in selected nests.

3. This permit is a non-exclusive personal right to access and entry the NIL and not a lease, easement or other interest in the NIL;
4. This permit is only issued to the bearer and whom have read and signed the "Release of Liability, Waiver of Claims, Assumption of Risks and Indemnity Agreement" (the "Release") which upon signature release from any right and claims from any and all liabilities due to any cause whatsoever in the NIL;
5. Furthermore, this permit is issued upon the following disclosed requisites:

- Disclosure by the Permittee at the satisfaction of Makivvik of sufficient insurance coverage;
- The Permittee sharing the research results with Makivvik;
- No interference with Inuit harvesting activities;
- Waste removal from the camp sites at closure by the Permittee, and minimal environmental impact approach by the Permittee throughout the conduct of the activity;
- Use by the Permittee of logistical support/transportation/guiding/rentals from local enterprises;
- No disturbance by the Permittee of archeological sites and no removal of material, being animated or not, from the authorized location;
- This permit approval is conditional on the permittee obtaining additional approvals from NMRPC, NMRIRB, NMRWB, CNG, EMRPC and EMRIRB.

6. Makivvik shall not be liable for any loss or damage to the Permittee, its agents, employees, contractors, licensees or invitees arising from or occasioned by the granting of, or anything done pursuant to this permit;
7. The Permittee represents and warrants that it is and shall remain in compliance with all federal, territorial and municipal statutes, regulations, bylaws and orders in respect of its access, entry, activity or operations on the NIL;
8. Moreover, the Permittee shall comply with all terms and conditions issued by the Nunavik Marine Region Wildlife Board (the "NMRWB").
9. The Permittee shall, for the purpose of the intended activity, ensure the obtaining and possession of all required sport fishing permits as issued by the government of Nunavut.
10. The Permittee shall abide by and conform with any and all additional restrictions or conditions respecting sport fishing catch or possession limitations imposed by the NMWB.
11. Makivvik may revoke this Permit and retain all its recourses and claims for breach of any term and condition to this Permit, should the Permittee fail to correct such breach upon notification, or such longer period as the Makivvik deems reasonably necessary, following the delivery by Makivvik to the Permittee of written notice containing reasonable details of the breach and the required means for remediation or correction.
